

REAL MOMENTUM ► MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. On November 5, 2019, Texas voters overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion to CPRIT for a total \$6 billion investment in cancer research and prevention. **Houston-area benefits include:**

INVESTING IN THE RESEARCH CAPABILITIES OF HOUSTON-AREA RESEARCH ENTITIES

- **\$1.1 billion** in grants awarded to 9 Houston-area research entities
- **115 stellar researchers** and their labs recruited to Houston-area research entities
- Baylor College of Medicine achieved **NCI comprehensive cancer center** status – joining MD Anderson Cancer Center
- **\$1.08 billion** in direct follow-on funding raised by Houston-area CPRIT grantees
- **32 CPRIT core facility** awards and renewals in the Houston-area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through capital instrumentation and technical expertise

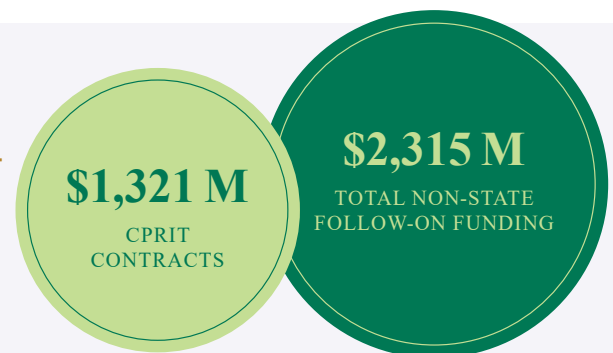
CREATING AND EXPANDING THE LIFE SCIENCE INFRASTRUCTURE BY ATTRACTING COMPANIES TO HOUSTON AND CREATING HIGH-QUALITY NEW JOBS

- **21 biotech** companies started, expanded, or brought to the Houston-area with CPRIT investment totaling **\$242 million**
- **\$1.23 billion** (almost 5 to 1) direct follow-on funding raised by Houston-area CPRIT companies
- **17** Houston-area CPRIT companies have established connections to Texas academic institutions
- **\$1.22 billion** total expenditures statewide in 2020
- **\$50.9 million** annual state and local tax collections
- **Over 8,558** permanent jobs created in 2020 in Texas

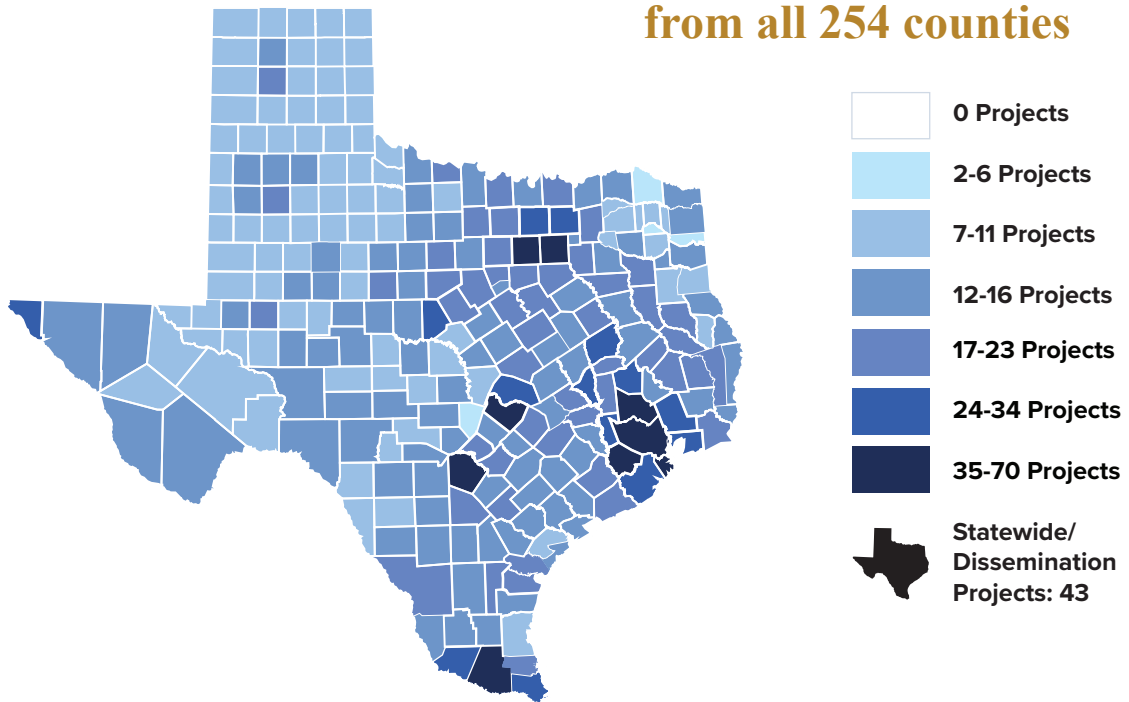
EXPEDITING INNOVATION BREAKTHROUGHS IN PREVENTION AND CURES

- 30,794 patients in 179 **clinical trials or studies** statewide
- **\$104 million** in grants awarded to 79 Houston-area prevention projects
- **23,008** cancer precursors and **4,179** cancers detected in Texas
- Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers
- **11 percent** of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects – proportionately 3 times more than national commitment

Follow-on funds (**\$2.32 Billion**) raised by academic research program grantees and CPRIT-funded companies in the Houston-area (**\$1.32 Billion**), exceeding contracted awards by **\$1.0 Billion**



Delivered 7.0 million prevention services to Texans from all 254 counties



CPRIT has enabled the recruitment of 115 scholars and 10 companies to Houston
