

REAL MOMENTUM ► MEASURABLE RESULTS

The Cancer Prevention & Research Institute of Texas was created in 2007 when Texans voted to invest \$3 billion in a historic fight against cancer. On November 5, 2019, Texas voters overwhelmingly approved a constitutional amendment to provide an additional \$3 billion to CPRIT for a total \$6 billion investment in cancer research and prevention. **Metroplex-area benefits include:**

INVESTING IN THE RESEARCH CAPABILITIES OF METROPLEX-AREA RESEARCH ENTITIES

- **\$521 million** in CPRIT grants awarded to six Metroplex-area research entities
- **87 stellar researchers** and their labs recruited to Metroplex-area research entities
- UT Southwestern Medical Center achieved **NCI comprehensive cancer center** status
- **\$501 million** in direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT grantees
- **Nine CPRIT core facility** awards and renewals in the Metroplex-area to provide access to cutting-edge shared technology through capital instrumentation and technical expertise

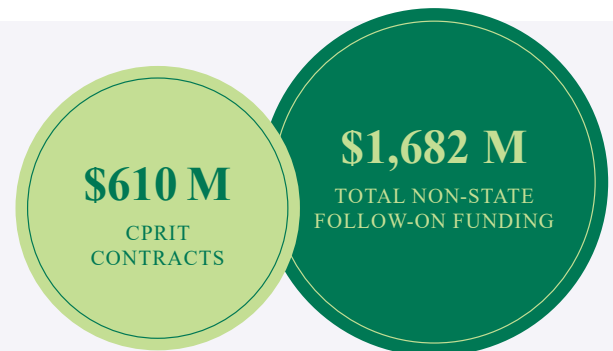
CREATING AND EXPANDING THE LIFE SCIENCE INFRASTRUCTURE BY ATTRACTING COMPANIES TO THE METROPLEX AND CREATING HIGH-QUALITY NEW JOBS

- **Seven** biotech companies started, expanded, or brought to Metroplex-area with CPRIT investment totaling **\$66 million**
- **\$1.18 billion** direct follow-on funding raised by Metroplex-area CPRIT companies
- **5** CPRIT-funded companies have established connections to Texas academic institutions
- **\$1.22 billion** total expenditures statewide in 2020
- **\$50.9 million** annual state and local tax collections
- **Over 8,558** permanent jobs created in 2020 in Texas

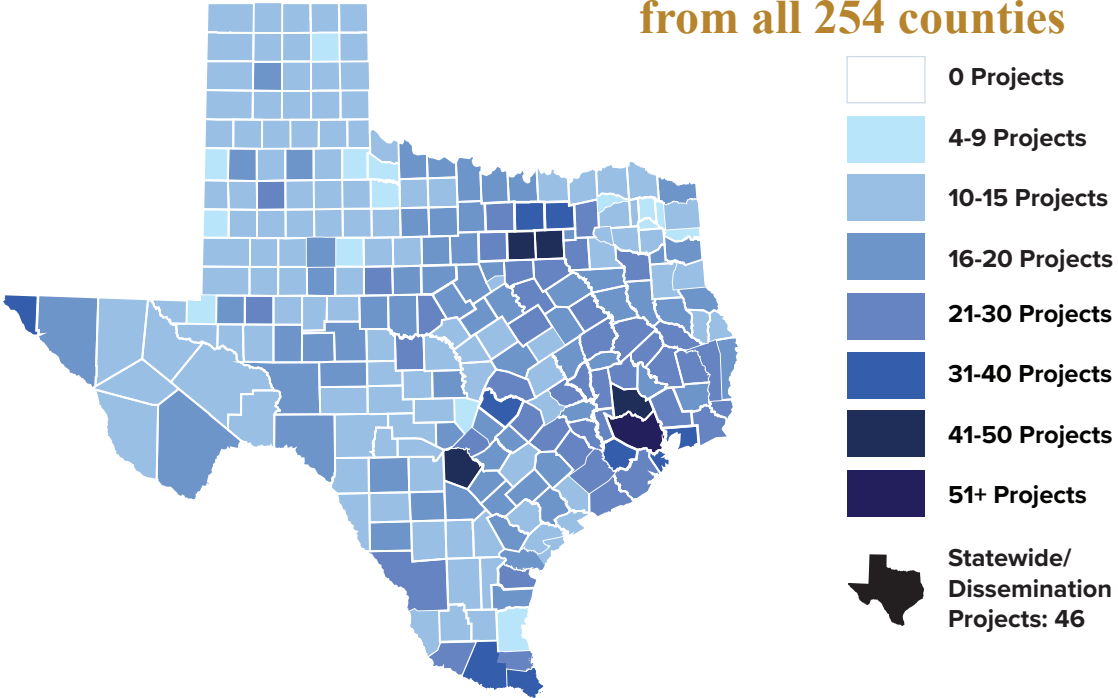
EXPEDITING INNOVATION BREAKTHROUGHS IN PREVENTION AND CURES

- 1412 patients in 28 **clinical trials or studies** in the Metroplex-area
- **\$300 million** in grants awarded to 258 prevention projects state-wide
- **25,349** cancer precursors and **4,436** cancers detected in Texas
- Nationally recognized teams and centers in immunotherapy and childhood cancers
- **11 percent** of CPRIT's portfolio goes to childhood cancer projects – proportionately three times more than national commitment

Follow-on funds (**\$1.682 Billion**) raised by academic research program grantees and CPRIT-funded companies in the Metroplex-area (**\$610 Million**), exceeding contracted awards by **\$1.072 Billion**



Delivered 7.6 million prevention services to Texans from all 254 counties



CPRIT has enabled the recruitment of 87 scholars to the Metroplex
